




The Team Internship Program (TIP)

- Student Teams: 2-5 members, Undergraduate, Masters, and Ph.D. Levels
- All engineering majors - we encourage multi-disciplinary teams
- Internship Details:
 - a. Paid Internships
 - b. 10-12 weeks over the summer
 - c. Full-time, i.e., 40 hour/week commitment

Cooperative Education (Co-op)

- First in the UC System
- Full-time (30-40 hours per week) for up to 6 months -Summer and Fall quarters
- Students must meet with an academic advisor to review course plan
- Employers may allow flexible work hours if you are taking classes

Recruiting Timeline

| October - December | Companies share openings and recruitment starts |
|--------------------|---|
| January - March | Companies continue to submit their openings and recruitment continues |
| April - May | Finalizing recruiting |
| June - September | Internships & Co-ops take place |
